



The **last week of June** the Youth will be serving at Delta Grace in Mississippi. I spoke with Rev. Veronica Pritchard, the owner/director of the mission, a few weeks ago who is excited that we are coming.

Since we started the Delta Grace ministry in January of 2014, we have hosted more than 1,600 missioners from 20 different states who have worked on more than 140 homes. We still have more than 300 applications on file of homes needing work. The people of the Mississippi Delta are gracious people in need of others willing to give them a hand up not a hand out.

Your team will work on homes within a 30 minute radius of the Delta Grace mission hub. The poverty rate within this area is approximately 35% which is

twice the poverty rate of the Appalachians Mountains. Many of the homes need bathroom repairs, kitchen repairs, floor repair and roof repair. But all the homes need people who love Christ and are willing to share His love with others.
